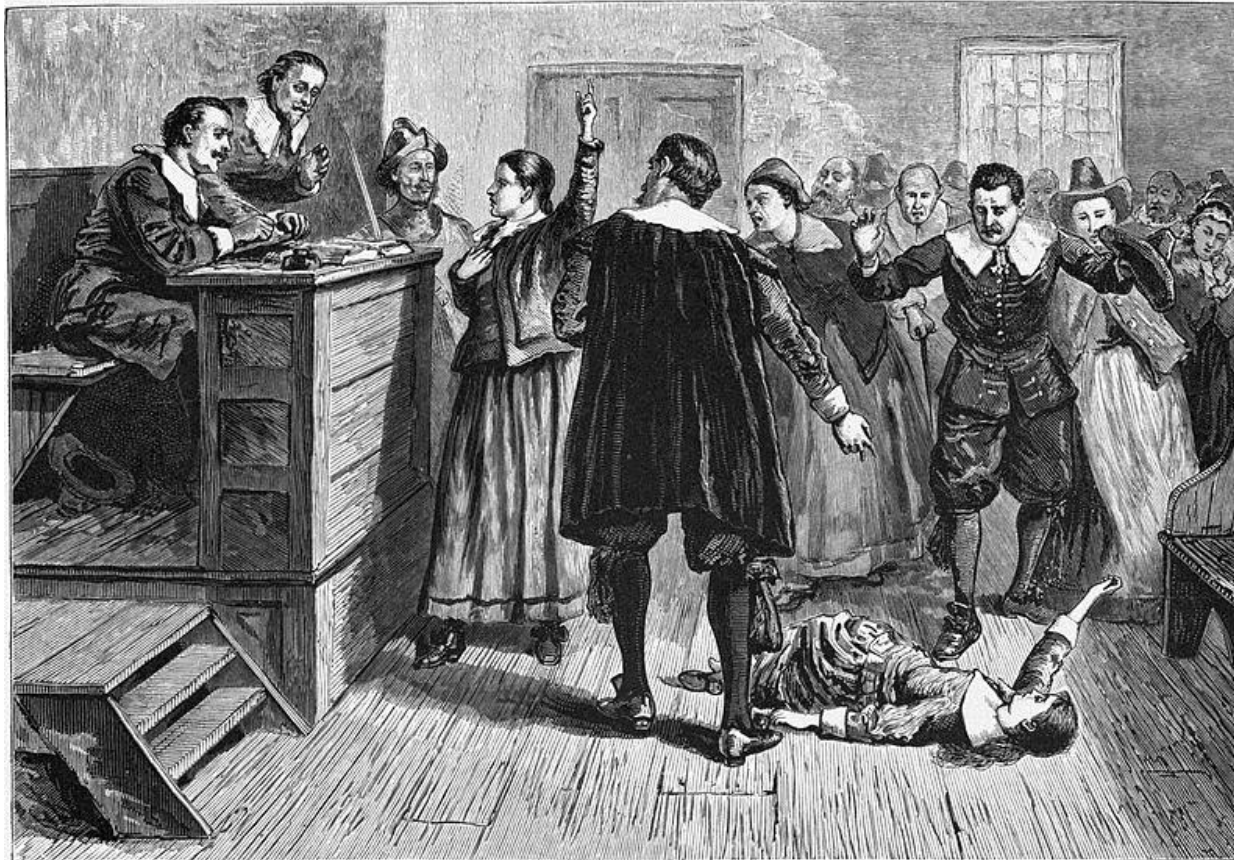
No executions took place in Waterbury, but the children of two executed people lived here after their parents' deaths.
