**Jean M. Auel** (pronounced “owl”)

### “First North American” Series by **W. Michael Gear and Kathleen O’Neal Gear**

Book 1: *People of the Wolf*, published in 1990. The authors delve into prehistoric Native American life. As of 2007, there were 14 books in this series.

### by **Sue Harrison**

Book 1: *Mother Earth, Father Sky*, published in 1990 (also available in large print)

This series begins during the last Ice Age, 7056 B.C. The author spent years studying many Native American languages. (See Interview in *Contemporary Authors*, vol. 135.)

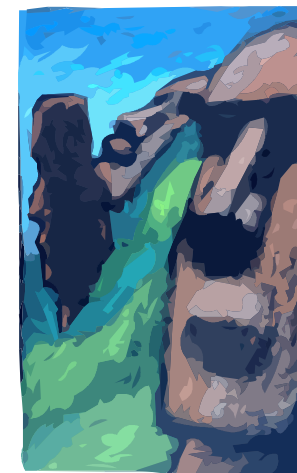
