LIBRARY COVID-19 UPDATE

Our buildings have reopened fully to the public as of May 11. Since then, our employees have been busy ensuring all safety requirements and guidelines have been met, including making improvements to the building, signing up new card holders, launching new online programs, adding to our ebook collection, and helping patrons via email and phone. We will continue providing patrons the option of an appointment to pick up materials and to use computers.

EBOOKS & AUDIOBOOKS

We have increased our collection of online books, including both ebooks and downloadable audiobooks. You can access them for free with the barcode number on your library card. You can adjust an ebook's font size, book layout, and lighting. As you read, you can also add bookmarks, create notes, highlight passages, and define words.

For audiobooks, you can skip backward or forward, increase playback speed up to 3x, and set a sleep timer until the end of the chapter or for 5, 10, 30 minutes, or more. To find out more, go to bronsonlibrary.org/ebooks.
