Everybody Learns Initiative

On October 7, Governor Lamont announced that \$2.6 million would be distributed to 65 libraries as part of the state's coronavirus relief response. We are one of the recipients of the grant, receiving \$74,190 to help us increase our capacity to serve the public during the pandemic.

The funds are to be used to purchase a variety of supplies and equipment, including PPE, disinfectants, plexiglas barriers, furniture with easy to clean surfaces, touchless soap dispensers, computers & tablets, etc.

The funds can also be used to purchase supplies for a popup library which would be used to bring the library to the neighborhoods. We are sorting out the details, but the general concept is to purchase fold-out book shelves on wheels which could be transported on a van. The popup library could be set up in a park pavilion or under a tent purchased for this use. The popup library would be equipped with Wi-Fi and with a portable heater in the winter.

We are also looking into supplies which would help us reopen at least part of the library for patrons who prefer to browse the shelves, and for patrons in need of a quiet study area.

Wowbrary

We are adding the Wowbrary service to our catalog and social media. Wowbrary will automatically generate a weekly email newsletter showcasing our new arrivals, with a link from the book cover to the catalog entry, and post summaries of our new arrivals to our social media. There is also a scrolling widget for our website.
