



I love her more than boys



My family and I Took a trip to the zoo And I saw a Koala bear, Giraffe and gnu.


Where the snakes are all kept And watched as the crocodiles Laid still and slept.




SPRING IS...

I was on the planet Mars and guess what, it was snowing stars!




